Chairperson Post called the meeting to order and stated the purpose of the meeting was a public hearing to discuss an ordinance to create Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Campbell creating a new zoning ordinance for such purpose to divide the Town of Campbell, Wisconsin, into districts of such number, shape and area as are deemed best suited to carry out the purposes: to provide a method for its administration and enforcement and to provide penalties for its violation.

When the chairperson opened the floor for public discussion, no one appeared in opposition to the ordinance.

Resident Rosalie Schnick complimented the commission on its work and voiced her support of the ordinance that will lead to Campbell's self-zoning.

In response to one of Mrs. Schnick's questions, Scott Johnson replied the ordinance reflects the current La Crosse County zoning ordinances applicable to Campbell as an urban town and had provisions for modification should the need arise.

Chad Hawkins said the county would have two meetings concerning the acceptance of our ordinance. Cassie Hanan confirmed the dates of the meetings as December 3 and 20. Helen Vitale is to remind the commission of the dates and whether or not it would be beneficial for us to appear before the county boards.

Chairperson Post said the commission would vote on the new ordinance at its meeting November 7.

Scott Johnson moved the meeting be adjourned. Joe Weitekamp seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
