ORDINANCE #2021-7**

**An Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Section 18-1 of the Town of Campbell Code of Ordinances Relating to Accumulation and Storage of Junk**

Section 18-1 Accumulation and storage of junk prohibited.

A) Nuisance declared.

Storage of old, unused, stripped, junked, unlicensed, and other automobiles not in condition for normal use or in good and safe operating condition, and of any other vehicles, machinery, implements, and/or equipment and personal property of any kind which is no longer usable for the purpose for which it was manufactured, which hereinafter are collectively described as "said personalty," for a period of five days or more (except in licensed junkyards) is hereby declared to be a nuisance and dangerous to the public safety.

B) Abatement by owner.

The owner, owners, tenants, lessees, and/or occupants of any lot within the Town upon which such storage is made, and also the owner, owners, and/or lessees of said personalty involved in such storage (all of whom will hereinafter be referred to collectively as owners), shall jointly and severally abate said nuisance by the prompt removal of said personalty to completely enclosed buildings authorized to be used for such storage purposes, or otherwise to remove it to a location without the corporate limits of the Town, and it shall be unlawful if said owners allow said nuisance to exist or fail to abate said nuisance.

C) Anyone found in violation of this section shall be subject to tiered fines as referenced in the Town of Campbell fee schedule.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by Section 60.80 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.
