

PFAS UPDATE October 8, 2024 - Lee Donahue, Supervisor #2 Health Education and Welfare

In the next 2-3 weeks the research team will be conducting more testing of our monitoring wells located south of Town Hall. This will be helpful as they analyze data and build models. This provides us more information on ground water flow, and characteristics of the Eau Claire formation which separates the aquifers.

There's still no movement on the \$125 million dollar trust fund approved in **June 2023** by a **bipartisan legislature**. I am continuing to request state and federal authorities to approve specific funding for our municipal water system.

A petition at url https://secure.everyaction.com/b5cx_f0Ia0KMBi7Z3Wwr4Q2 supports establishing state wide ground water standards. This step can assist impacted municipalities like Campbell and Peshtigo.

I am committed to exhausting all state, county and federal funding opportunities to make a long term solution for safe drinking water a reality in Campbell.
