3) BUSINESS:

- A)** Discussion and possible action regarding a letter of support for the Wisconsin Groundwater Joint Solicitation in regards to the PFAS studies.

Supervisor Donahue indicated that the DNR reached out to the UW-Madison team for a groundwater study project. This study would be used as a template to help other communities who also face contamination issues. There would be no cost for the Town of Campbell to offer support. This project is in conjunction to the ongoing PFAS study that the UW-Madison team is currently conducting. Supervisor Donahue will draft the letter.

Motion to approve a letter of support for the Wisconsin Groundwater Joint Solicitation in regards to the PFAS studies was made by Supervisor Donahue/Supervisor Stratman. Motion carried 5-0.
