

PFAS UPDATE December 10, 2024 - Lee Donahue, Supervisor #2 Health Education and Welfare

The UW-Madison consortium which includes USGS and WGNHS are working to design some initial ground water flow models. We've already seen the groundwater flow impacted by the river levels and sometimes the season.

We continue to explore funding options for an independent municipal water system using federal agency and state funding. Last Wednesday I participated in the listening session at Northside elementary with the Governor and his staff. I'm told PFAS impacted communities remain a priority for funding.

I will continue working to access to the \$125 million dollar PFAS trust fund approved year and a half ago.

I will collaborate with Davy engineering and our state and federal officials to exhaust all state, county and federal funding opportunities to make a long-term solution for safe drinking water a reality in Campbell.
