3) Business:

1. Site Plan Review for parcel #04-01284-000, J & T Noyes LLC, 816 Bainbridge Street.

John Noyes, 816 Bainbridge Street, described the project as construction of an engineered silo that will be 40' Diameter and less than 140' tall. The silo will be used to contain cementitious material delivered either by rail, or by barge containers. The project will include a barge container unloader. John has written approval from the La Crosse fire department for a structure up to 140' maximum.

A motion was made by Joe Weitekamp to recommend to the Town of Campbell Board to Approve the project on parcel #04-01284-000 for a silo engineered to contain cementitious material, with a finished height not to exceed 140'. The motion was seconded by Al Macha. Motion to approve carried 6-0.
